**CONGRATULATIONS BISHOP MARK:** Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Mark O'Toole as Archbishop-elect of Cardiff and Bishop-elect of Menevia. Bishop O'Toole has been Bishop of Plymouth since his appointment in 2013. He will become the eighth archbishop of Cardiff in succession to Archbishop George Stack, who has been Archbishop of Cardiff since 2011. The installation will take place in Cardiff Cathedral on 20<sup>th</sup> June, the feast day of Welsh martyrs Saints Julius and Aaron.
