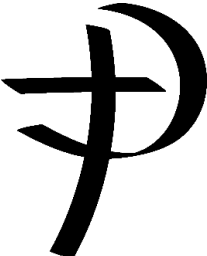

Buckfast Abbey is looking to appoint the following position: Independent Chair of Buckfast Abbey Safeguarding Commission.

The Commission, which normally meets quarterly, is accountable to the Trustees and has regulatory, advisory and supportive functions. It operates at a strategic level in liaison with the Abbot, Trustees and the Safeguarding Co-ordinator in all matters concerning the Safeguarding of Children and Adults.
