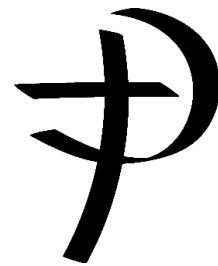

Peace Sunday will be held next Sunday 18th January.

The Bishops' Conference encourage us all to use the day to reflect on the Pope's message for the World Day of Peace on the 1st January. Pope Leo said that the theme for his message was, *'Peace be with you all: towards an 'unarmed and disarming' peace'.*

**SPUC - Abortion up to Birth Bill
and Assisted Suicide Bill.**

Both of these Bills are currently being scrutinised and debated in the House of Lords. Thank you if you have already written to some Peers but, we need you to keep up the pressure and continue writing. This is because the Government has now allocated another 10 days for debate, ending on the 24 April, to deal with the 1071 Amendments tabled for the **Leadbeater Assisted Suicide Bill**.

The **Abortion up to Birth Bill** will be debated on **27th January**. Amendments have been tabled to remove the Bill and end the pills by post policy.

We now have more time to lobby members of the House of Lords.
