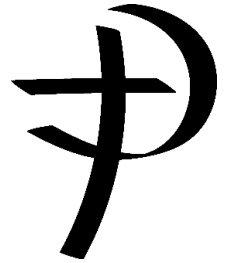

Fr Louis Rieunier from Plymouth Diocese, our former Parish Priest here at Yelverton, has been appointed as spiritual director at the Beda from the summer. He replaces Fr Peter who is returning to active retirement in his diocese of Lancaster after eleven years at the Beda. The announcement was made in Plymouth Diocese at the end of February. Fr Louis said: "I am happily looking forward to returning to the Beda, where I undertook my own formation to the priesthood, and taking-up my new appointment." We keep Fr Louis in our prayers as he makes his preparation.
