CATECHESIS: KNOW YOUR FAITH

The Creed is a summary statement or profession of the Christian faith. We have two forms of it: The Apostles Creed and the Nicene Creed (from the first two ecumenical Councils of the Nicaea in 325 and Constantinople in 381). They are known as Symbols of Faith. We use them both at prayer and at Mass, and the key beliefs of the church and members in the Creed include:

- A. The Oneness of God and Trinity
- B. The Incarnation of Jesus Christ as the Son of God
- C. Crucifixion, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus
- D. Work of the Holy Spirit
- E. The Church as the body of Christ
- F. Communion of saints
- G. Sin and the means of salvation
- H. Judgement and world to come
