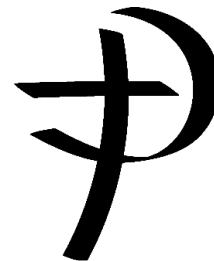

Assisted Suicide

SPUC (Society for the Protection of Unborn Children) Urgent Notice - A Bill to allow assisted suicide will be laid before parliament this month. If passed, it would cause a complete change in the way society deals with terminally and chronically ill people. People must be treated as equal in value and dignity and not as lives 'not worth living'. Assisted Suicide would place pressure on vulnerable people. Most palliative care doctors denounce these measures. Palliative Care is the Cinderella of the NHS and will remain so if assisted suicide is introduced.

This will give you information on what to include in your letter and invites you to enter your postcode which will bring up your MP and allow you to write an email which they will send.
