SPUC CAMPAIGN 'JUSTICE FOR BABY LILY' TO END DIY ABORTIONS. The "pills by post" policy (DIY abortions) has been in place for 3*yrs, when it became lawful for women to self-induce the abortion of their own baby during the Coronavirus pandemic without meeting with a medical professional. This policy has now become permanent. The fallout from this law has been drawn to public attention when Carla Foster, from Staffordshire, was sentenced to imprisonment after it was found that she lied to abortion provider BPAS to obtain abortion drugs well past the legal limit for abortion. Her daughter Lily was born dead at 32-34 weeks gestation. Because of this case, and others, abortion providers have argued for abortion to be decriminalised.
