CATECHESIS: KNOW YOUR FAITH

We are in the season of Advent. It is the first liturgical year of the Church, known as 'Year A'. It begins the three-year cycle of the story of our salvation in the Church. Advent is a period of preparation to commemorate the first coming of Jesus at Christmas. But the Church also uses the season to remind us of Christ's second coming. It is a time of spiritual preparation for Christmas through prayers, love of God and neighbour, the practice of good virtues, reception of the Sacraments especially the sacrament of Penance, and charitable works towards the poor and the needy.

Nine Lessons & Carol Service for both parishes will be held at 4pm on Sunday 18th December at Our Lady of the Assumption Church, Tavistock, followed by refreshments.
