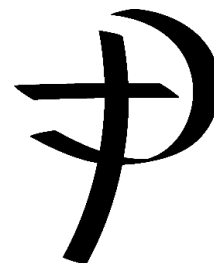

CATECHESIS: KNOW YOUR FAITH

The Creed is a summary statement or profession of the Christian faith. We have two forms of it: The Apostles Creed and the Nicene Creed (**from the first two ecumenical Councils of the Nicaea in 325 and Constantinople in 381**). They are known as Symbols of Faith. We use them both at prayer and at Mass. The key beliefs of the church and members in the Creed include:

- The Oneness of God and Trinity
- The Incarnation of Jesus Christ as the Son of God
- Crucifixion, death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus
- Work of the Holy Spirit
- The Church as the body of Christ
- Communion of saints
- Sin and the means of salvation
- Judgement and world to come
