With great joy and gratitude, we look ahead to the upcoming Episcopal Ordination and Installation of our new Bishop, Christopher Whitehead. As much as we would wish for all who desire to take part in the Mass to be present in the Cathedral on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February at 12noon we deeply regret that its seating capacity is extremely limited to 500.

In an effort to allocate seats fairly, each parish in the diocese will be given two tickets so that all our parishes will be represented.
