Share the Journey Campaign Walk: This year, the Holy Father urges us to reach out to our brothers and sisters who are forced to flee their homes. You can Share the Journey by joining us on a walk. Schools, parishes, and local communities across England and Wales, including our own, will be walking to show solidarity with people on the move.

Together, we are aiming for 24,900 miles - the distance around the whole world. CAFOD will use this shared journey to deliver a powerful message to world leaders, who meet in September 2018 to agree two global agreements on refugees and migration.

Share the Journey - Holy Cross and Our Lady of Lourdes, Plympton shared Parish event, taking place on **Sunday 1st July**. Everyone is invited to join in at whatever level you can. For those feeling really energetic we are aiming to do the 9.2 mile walk leaving Our Lady of Lourdes, Plympton straight after 9am Mass at Our Lady's and taking the route through Plymbridge Woods to Holy Cross, where we will share some well-earned refreshments*.
