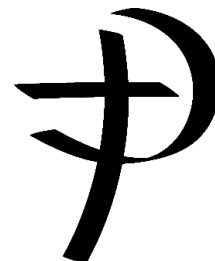

Note from the Dean: To adjust to changed circumstances, we need to make some adjustments to the pastoral arrangements in place in the eastern part of our Plymouth Deanery this year.

So that everyone knows what these changes will be and how they could affect them, there will be a meeting at Plympton church hall on **Thursday 2nd June at 7pm** which anyone from the deanery is welcome to attend. At that meeting the Canon John Deeny and Fr Petroc Cobb will be available to explain the changes and the reasons for them. It is an opportunity for anyone to ask questions about the changes and find out what they want to know.

Parishioners from the eastern part of the deanery are especially encouraged to come to the meeting, but anyone from the deanery will be most welcome.

Thy Kingdom Come. This is a global prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for more people to come to know Jesus.

Since its start in May 2016, God has grown Thy Kingdom Come from a dream of possibility into a movement. Christians from 172 countries have taken part in praying 'Come Holy Spirit', so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to faith in Jesus Christ.

This year 'Thy Kingdom Come' have produced resources which are all available online via the link in the attached document. There are resources for children as well as adults, the resources can be printed off and used within your Diocese, or can just be shared/viewed online. Pentecost Vigil Prayer: You are invited to a time of prayer and scriptural reflection before the Blessed Sacrament from 9pm until midnight, at St. Peter's, Crownhill on Saturday, June 4th. As the disciples gathered in the upper room in prayer on the eve of Pentecost, likewise we pray that the Church and all its members may be renewed in the power of the Holy Spirit to carry out its mission and proclaim the saving news of Jesus Christ.
