Extraordinary Ministers of The Eucharist

Julia Beacroft from the Evangelisation & Catechesis Team in the Diocese of Plymouth will be offering a training day for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and also those interested in becoming one.

This will take place on Saturday 16th November at 10.15am at St. Peter's, Crownhill Parish.

The training day will consist of 3 modules of learning as follows:

- Module 1: The Body & Blood of Christ Source & summit of the Catholic faith. This module explores scriptural historical references, including the cooperation between God and humankind.
- Module 2: A Way of Life. Examines all practical aspects of ministering both at the altar & taking Holy Communion to the sick & housebound.
- Module 3: An encounter with Jesus. What other service can Eucharistic Ministers provide?
