SVP As you may have spotted a lack of notices in the Parish Newsletters giving details of SVP meetings during the Pandemic some of you may be wondering whether our SVP conference is still going. The answer is that it certainly is. Of course we have not been able to hold physical meetings and we decided that in view of the size of our conference we did not need virtual meetings as all conference business could be transacted via email. We have continued to keep in contact, mainly by telephone, with our existing beneficiaries and added some new ones. Apart from such contacts we have continued to support our twinned conferences in India, run the Christmas Sudan Baby Feeding Appeal and supported Syrian refugee families in Tavistock and Plymouth by donation of excellent clothing, children's toys, furniture (including beds) and bicycles and helmets.
