CATECHESIS: KNOW YOUR FAITH. It is a norm for Catholics to begin and end prayers with: IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. This is the standard practice whether in private or public prayer. We need to distinguish between a nonprayer and prayer moment by the invocation of the name of the Trinity. Let's practice this and make it part of us.

There are scheduled postal strikes through much of November, so advice is that cards for abroad need to go earlier than planned. When buying stamps please consider asking for the religious design.
